## Why am I here?

Your mission is to develop an understanding of how the Markets Division operates, with the purpose of developing your analytical knowledge, skills and capabilities. You will also develop and leverage networks with the Apollo Programme and Young Professionals group to encourage collaborative and cross functional learning, thinking and decision making with the wider Trustpower team.

- Embrace opportunities for gaining cross-functional insights within Markets and leveraging those to identify opportunities for improvement
- Encourage collaborative and cross functional learning, thinking and decision making with the wider Trustpower team

- Be a change agent

## What does my mission look like?

Your programme will run for two years and you will start in the Insights & Analytics team –

Timeframe	Description
8 months	Insights and Analytics team –  Learn, understand and use tools, systems, processes and data that will enable data driven decision making and insights.  Supporting analysts in delivering data insights and working collaboratively with other teams to drive data decision making.
8 months	Pricing team –  Learn about the markets that Trustpower operates in, competitor behaviour, Trustpower products and pricing, and how we manage our customer's price journey in our systems and processes; use this learning to identify opportunities and implement process improvements.
8 months	Commercial Analysis team -  Designing and conducting profitability analysis for new market offers using both Market Analytics and Pricing; using technical expertise to apply pricing knowledge to the wider business.

## What Support will I have?

**Rotation Manager** – For each rotation you will report to the team or department Manager. This person will support you day to day and assign you tasks/projects, arrange any training you may need and provide you with any advice/guidance you require.

**Buddy** – For the duration of the programme, you will have a buddy from within the Department (they may or may not be in your team) who you can connect with whenever you need someone to bounce ideas off, find out who can provide support to you in your individual or group work, and to provide general ongoing support. These people could be from any level of the organisation from a team mate, through to a Department Manager or Senior Leadership Team member.

**People & Capability Buddy** – For the duration of the programme, you will be assigned a buddy from within the People & Capability team. This person can provide support, advice and guidance.

**Mentor** – For the duration of the programme, you will be assigned a mentor. This person will provide information and resources to help you along your development journey, as well as be another person who can offer support and guidance from a differing perspective. These people could be from any level of the organisation from a team mate, through to a Department Manager or Senior Leadership Team member.
